Application Timeline:

Students may apply to the Roosevelt in Washington Fellowship via our Early Application or our Regular Application. Students who apply Early do not have an advantage during the application review process and we never fill our entire cohort only from the Early pool.



Early Application Deadline: December 8, 2024 Application opens October 9, 2024 Notified of next steps by January 21, 2025

Regular Application Deadline: February 7, 2025 Application opens January 3, 2025 Notified of next steps by March 4, 2025

You should apply for the Roosevelt in Washington Fellowship if you:

- Are currently a sophomore or junior in the '24-25 academic year
- Are enrolled full-time in a bachelor's degree program at a US-based institution with at least one term left in the '25-26 school year.
- Are a US citizen, permanent resident, or DACA recipient (international students are not eligible for Network fellowships).
- Are able to live & work 40 hours in D.C. for 8 weeks in June/July 2025.

- Can commit 5 hours/week to assignments and real-time, virtual engagements.
- Can commit to attending a mandatory, inperson Roosevelt Network conference at the FDR Presidential Library and Museum from Thursday, July 31 - Sunday, August 3, 2025 (Roosevelt will pay for all travel and lodging).
